LIFE CIRCforBIO participates, with several presentations and references as well as poster in the dedicated online platform, at the 9th International Conference held in Corfu on Municipal Waste Management from June 15-18 in hybrid form.

The conference is organized by the Unit of Environmental Science & Technology of NTUA, Prof. Mrs. Maria Loizidou and co-organizers the Waste to Energy Research & Technology Council, the Region of Ionian Islands and the Municipality of Central Corfu & Diapontia Islands, at the Municipal Theater of other parts of the island.
